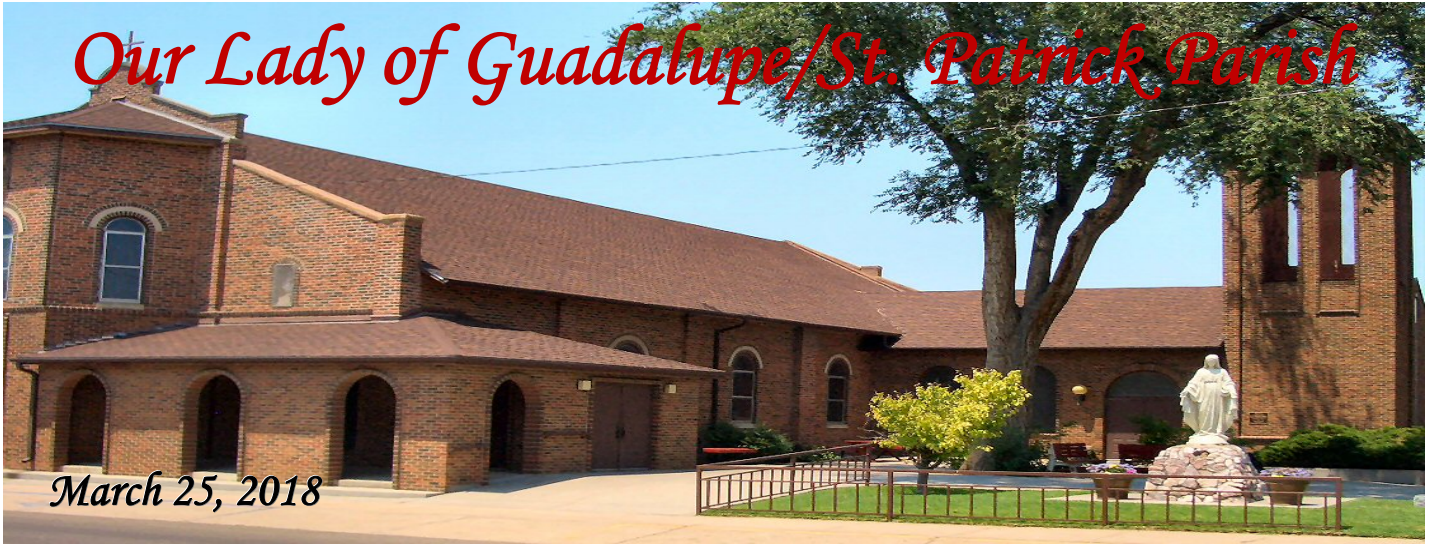

Sacrament of Baptism for Infants: If you have a child under the age of 7 who has not yet been baptized, classes are available in Spanish and English. **GODPARENTS MUST BE CONFIRMED, ACTIVE MEMBERS OF THE CHURCH.** Please call the office to pre-register, or if you have any questions. **The next class will be April 15 @1:00.**

Sacrament of Marriage: Couples should contact the Priest at least six months in advance.

Adult Sacraments of Initiation: If you have never been baptized and are over 7 years old, OR if you were baptized in another Christian church, OR if you were baptized as an infant in the Catholic Church, but didn't receive the other Sacraments of Communion and/or Confirmation, please call the office to learn more about how you can become a fully initiated member of the Catholic Church.

Adult Confirmation: Classes are held Tuesdays at 6:00 PM in the Parish Hall. Contact the Office for information.

Pastor's Note: Anyone desiring to enter into sacramental preparation should begin attending Mass regularly and making a resolution to live the faith, showing readiness. If the person is in a union that is not a marriage in the Church, this situation will need to be reconciled with the Church prior to the reception of the Sacrament(s). If a previous marriage is involved, a petition for a declaration of invalidity will need to be prepared and sent to the Diocesan Tribunal. Please contact the Office information.

Palm branches are widely recognized symbol of peace and victory, and at Mass on Palm Sunday the faithful will wave palms as they reenact Jesus' arrival in Jerusalem. The palms are blessed and many people will fashion them into small crosses or other items of personal devotion. These may be returned to the church, or kept for the year. Because the palms are blessed, they may not be discarded as trash. Instead, they are gathered at the church and burned to create the ashes that will be used in the following year's Ash Wednesday observance.

Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion, March 25, is the final Sunday of Lent, and it's the beginning of Holy Week. It commemorates the **triumphant arrival of Christ in Jerusalem**, just days before he was crucified. In the Gospels, Jesus enters Jerusalem riding a young donkey, to the lavish praise of the townspeople who threw clothes, or possibly palms or small branches, in front of him as a sign of homage. This was a customary practice for people of great respect.

The joy of welcoming Jesus with shouts of "Hosanna" is quickly crushed, as the Scripture readings recount the heartbreaking Passion narrative. **We journey with Jesus on the road to Calvary**, and we share the shock and bewilderment His Mother and followers must have felt. In confusion and grief, we enter the holiest week of the year.
