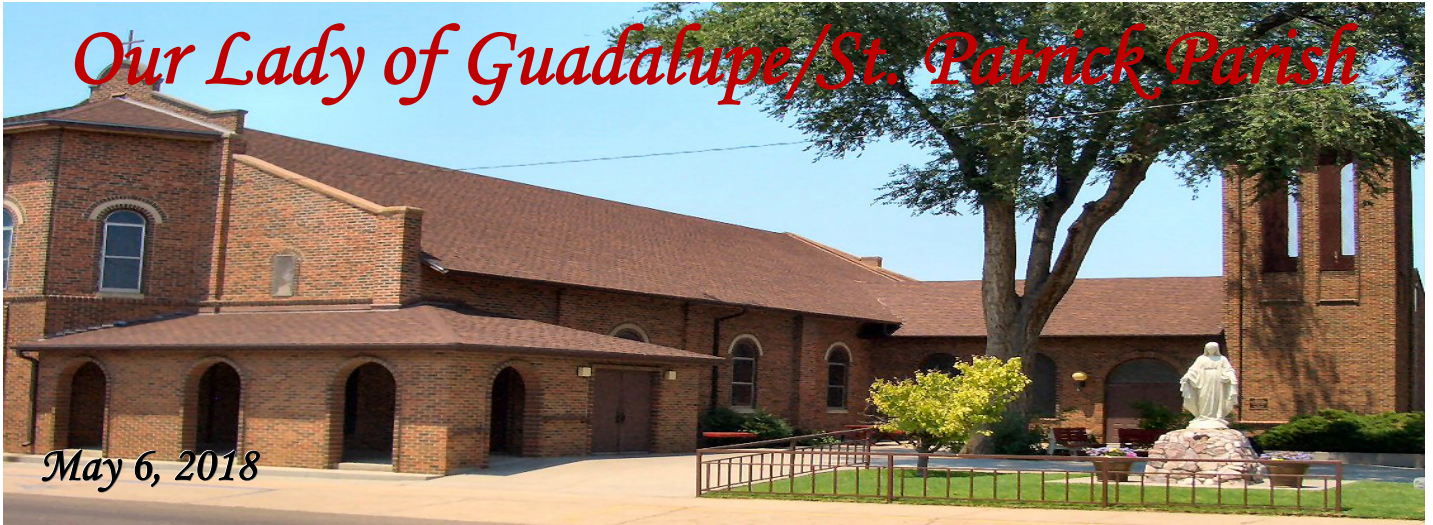

Next **Baptism Class** for parents and godparents of infants under the age of 7 will be held August 19, 2018. Please call the Office to pre-register. Godparents must be Confirmed, active members of the Church. Classes are available in Spanish and English.

Faith Formation for children Kdg-High School is ongoing. These classes are for all children, including those over the age of 7, who have not yet been Baptized or received their First Holy Communion.

Couples wishing to prepare for the **Sacrament of Marriage** should contact the Priest at least six months in advance.

Adult Faith Formation meets with Father Wertin on Mondays at 5:30 p.m. in the Parish Hall. **Everyone is invited, including those who have never been baptized, AND those who were baptized in another Christian church, AND those who were baptized as an infant in the Catholic Church, but didn't receive the other Sacraments of Communion and/or Confirmation,** as well as anyone wishing to grow in their faith!

Pastor's Note: Anyone desiring to enter into sacramental preparation should begin attending Mass regularly and making a resolution to live the faith, showing readiness. If the person is in a union that is not a marriage in the Church, this situation will need to be reconciled with the Church prior to the reception of the Sacrament(s). If a previous marriage is involved, a petition for a declaration of invalidity will need to be prepared and sent to the Diocesan Tribunal. Please contact the Office for more information.

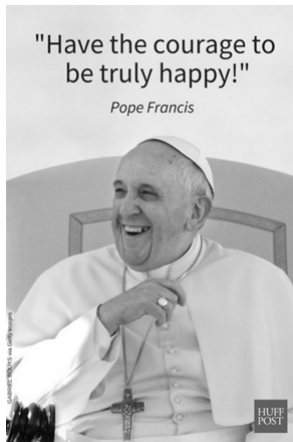

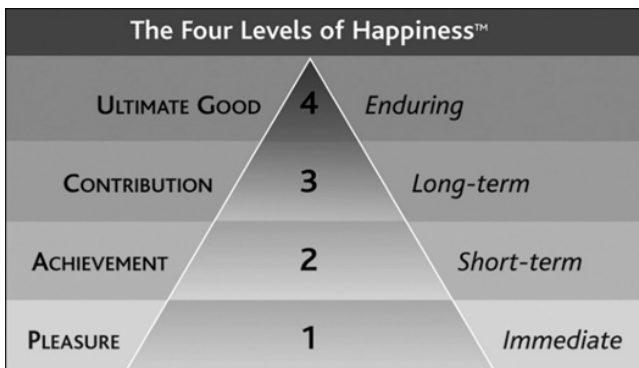


MARK YOUR CALENDAR NOW FOR SATURDAY, JUNE 23!
